

# Implementation Process

## Introduction



There are many approaches to implementing a greenway in the Chattahoochee River Corridor.

The exact approach in implementing a greenway will depend on the project's goals, size, budget, and political climate. This section reviews greenway implementation (Figure 32) from master planning through design and construction to the greenway's grand opening day. However it is implemented, each greenway project should incorporate the Chattahoochee River Greenway Principles and Guide-

lines, as presented in *Principles and Guidelines*. To emphasize the connection between the implementation process and the principles, each topic covered in this section contains a review of the principles and guidelines relevant to that topic. These guidelines provide a more detailed explanation of various concepts and how they relate to that section of the project process.

In this handbook, a *greenway segment* is a section of the Chattahoochee River Corridor. A *greenway project* is defined as the process of planning, land acquisition, design, construction, and management of a segment of the Chattahoochee River Corridor.
